2023 ANNUAL REPORT

Habitat for Humanity of Greater Moses Lake (HFHGML) faced a significant slowdown during the COVID-19 pandemic. However, with a focused strategy and a united effort to enhance their outreach, the board members and staff effectively reinvigorated their involvement within the Moses Lake community.

HFHGML concentrated its efforts on supporting residents in Moses Lake, WA, through the introduction of two pivotal programs: A Brush With Kindness and Homeownership. These initiatives underscore the organization's dedication to serving the local community.

HFHGML, despite its size and rural location, is committed to diligently serving the community. The organization's vision statement, "A world where everyone has a decent place to live," serves as a beacon in our efforts. In 2023, the organization achieved the following milestones:

- Successfully executed a Critical Repair project benefiting a local disabled veteran.
- Accomplished three home repair and improvement projects.
- Conducted a Homeowner Information Night.
- Engaged in volunteer activities with local businesses and nonprofit organizations.
- Received support from more than 40 volunteers during the annual gala event.

The proceeds from the auction will be allocated to benefit the Homeowner and A Brush With Kindness programs. The projected cost for constructing a new build spanning 1205 square feet stands at \$231,000, additionally, the organization has earmarked \$65,000 for the A Brush With Kindness program.
